Protect Yourself With These Cyber Security Tips

Scammers are out this holiday season. Keep you and your family safe with these tips.

- ✓ Keep your devices up-to-date to ensure you have the latest security patches.
- ✓ Avoid sharing live updates on social media. Make sure you eliminate location data, addresses, or personal information with connections you don't know in real life.
- ✓ Add a second layer of security to your accounts with multi-factor authentication, like having a code sent to your phone and entering a password.
- ✓ If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is. When someone reaches out with an offer, don't send money, share personal information, or click links until you can verify it.
- ✓ Remember: The IRS will never ask you to make a wire transfer, and most communication comes through the mail. When in doubt, call them directly: 800-829-1040.

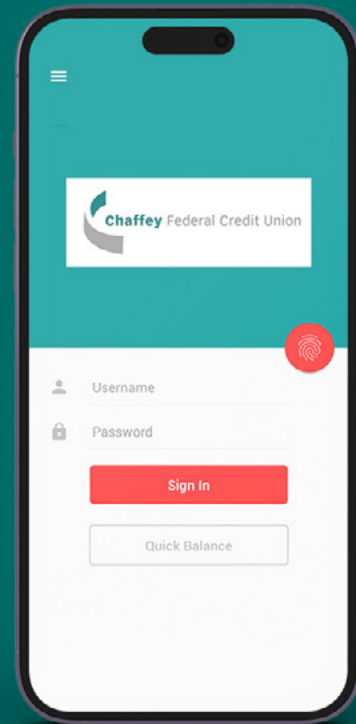
